

DIY Bookmarks

Courtesy of Fabric Traditions®

Supplies & Tools:

- ¼ yard of Fabric Traditions Novelty Prints Fabric
- Optional: ¼ yard Fabric Traditions Blender Print to match
- Thread – contrasting or to match
- Basic sewing tools – pins, needle, sewing machine, iron

Directions

1. Cut three squares to be 4.5” all around. If using a contrasting fabric cut one out of that fabric and two out of novelty fabric.
2. Take one of the three squares and fold it in half diagonally, to create a triangle, with wrong sides together and press flat. If using contrasting fabric this piece will be folded in half.
3. Lay one square face up and place the folded square on top. Make sure the fold goes diagonally across the square and the raw edges all line up with each other.
4. Place the second square face down over the other two fabrics and pin together.
5. Stitch around using a ¼” allowance and leave a 1” opening on one side. We suggest leaving the opening on a side without excess fabric from the folded square.
6. Clip the corners of the bookmark for easy turning and turn right-side out. Slip stitch the hole closed and press flat.
7. Using a ¼” or ½” stitch, top stitch around the entire bookmark and enjoy!
