

DIY Hair Ties

Supplies & Tools:


- Scraps of Fabric Traditions Calico or Novelty Prints Fabric
- Elastic hair bands
- Bow Template (can find below)
- Basic sewing supplies – pins, needle, thread, sewing machine

Directions

1. Cut out the bow template below. Using the same fabric or two different fabrics, cut out 2 pieces of the template.
2. With right sides together, pin and stitch around the bow using a $\frac{1}{4}$ th” seam allowance. Make sure to leave a 2” gap along one of the straight parts of the bow.
3. Turn the bow right side out and press flat making sure the seam allowance for the gap is pressed neatly inside the bow. Use an invisible stitch to close the opening.
4. Optional: Top stitch using a $\frac{1}{8}$ th” stitch around the bow.
5. Using a single knot, tie the bow around your hair tie.
6. Throw your hair up and enjoy!
