RIBBON DANCE QUILT

SKILL LEVEL: Advanced

CRAFTING TIME: Weekend Project

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Supplies & Tools

- You will need the following 14 amounts of Maisie's Garden fabrics
 - 1 3/4 yards of pattern D60-A
 - 1 3/4 yards of pattern D59-A
 - 1/4 yard pattern D61-G
 - 1/4 yard pattern D57-A
 - 1/4 yard pattern D58-C
 - 1/4 yard pattern D56-C
 - 1/4 yard pattern D56-A
 - 1/4 yard pattern D62-A
 - 1/4 yard pattern D62-G
 - 1/4 yard pattern D60-G
 - 1/4 yard pattern D57-G
 - 1/4 yard pattern 58-A
 - 3 3/4 yards backing fabric
- 54" x 68" quilt batting
- Thread to match fabrics
- Sewing Machine
- Pencil, ruler, and template plastic, OR rotary cutter, mat and ruler
- Iron
- Scissors
- Pins and a sewing needle

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Directions

1. Stitch all seams right sides together using $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance unless indicated.

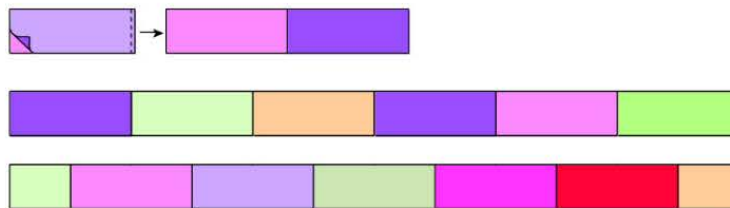
2. From D60-At, six crosswise border strips $42 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $7 \frac{3}{4}$ ". From two strips, cut four more pieces 14 " x $7 \frac{3}{4}$ " and stitch these to the crosswise strips to make borders that. Cut $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 " rectangles.

3. From D59-A, cut two inner borders $49 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " and two inner borders $38 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $1 \frac{1}{2}$ ". cut six 45 " x 3 " binding strips, trim ends diagonally. Cut eight $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 ".

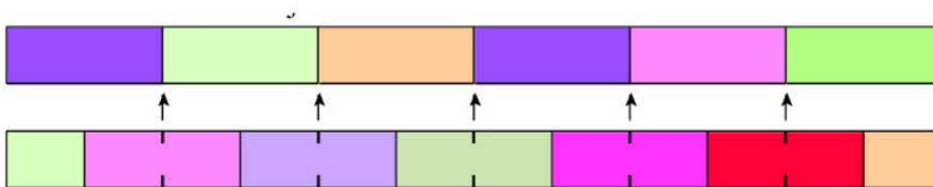
4. From each of the remaining fabrics, cut six to nine rectangles $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 ". You will need a total of 91 rectangles.

5. Arrange the rectangles varying the prints and colors in 14 vertical rows. There are six rectangles in row one and each odd numbered row. There are five complete rectangles in row two and each even numbered row. Trim two rectangles for the top and bottom of the even number rows to $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 ".

6. Stitch the rectangles in each row together along the short edges. See figures below.



7. Mark the center of the side edge of each rectangle. Pin the rows together matching the mark to the seam line of the adjacent row.



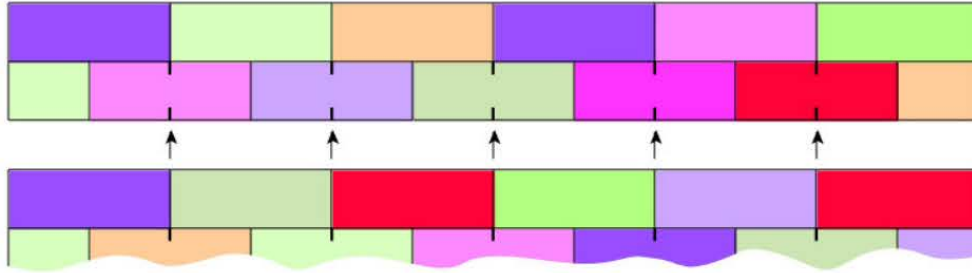
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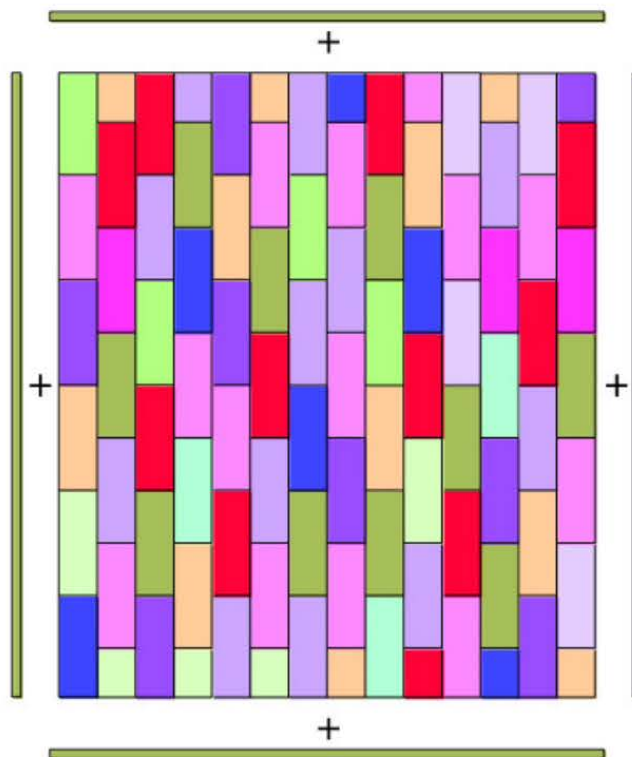

8. Stitch the rows together in pairs. Then stitch the pairs to complete the center.



9. Trim the long edge of the longer inner border strips even with the sides of the quilt center. Stitch one strip to each side. Then trim the remaining inner border strips even with the top and bottom edges of the quilt center including the inner borders. Stitch one strip to each top and bottom edge. See figure below.

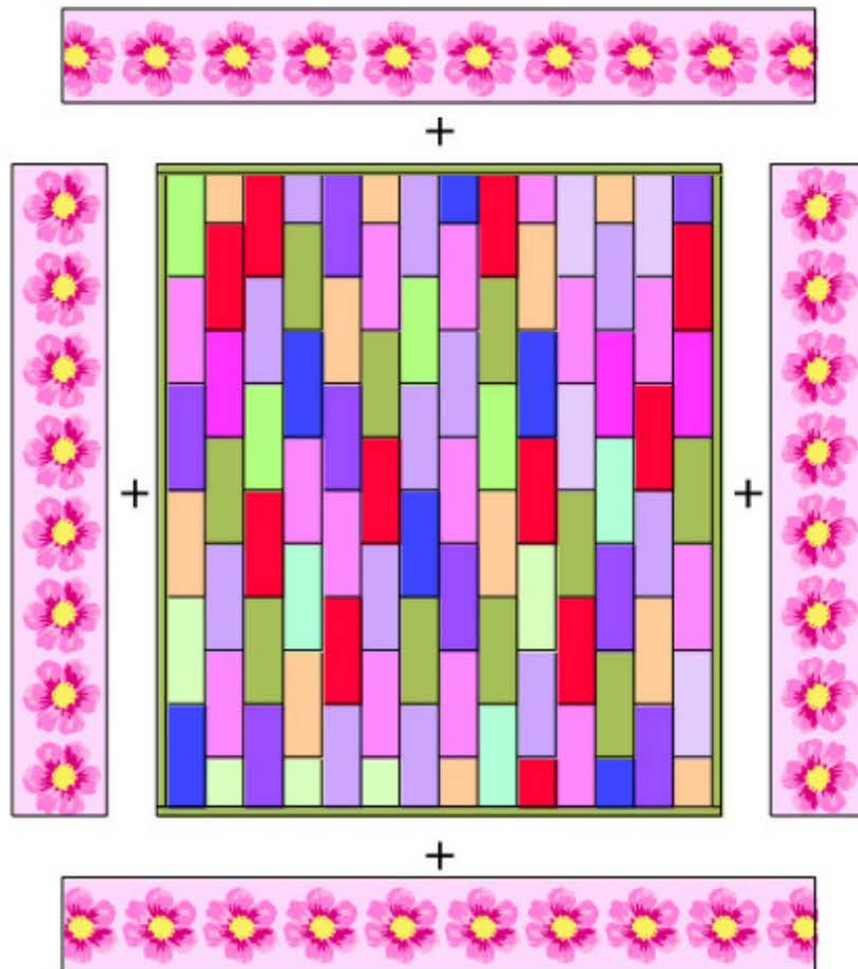


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Directions

- Mark the center of each inner border strip. Pin a border strip to each side edge matching the center of the space between two large pin flowers to the center of the inner border, then stitch it in place. Trim ends of the borders even with the top and bottom of the inner borders. Stitch the remaining two border strips to the top and bottom of the quilt in the same way. See figure below.

- 11.** Layer quilt and bind the edges.

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
