SEW-IT PET BOWTIE

SKILL LEVEL: BEGINNER

CRAFTING TIME: 1 HOUR

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Supplies & Tools

- 3/4 yard of Bow, Wow, Meow fabric
- Sewing Machine
- Needle and coordinating thread
- Scissors or pinking sheers
- Pins and iron

Directions

1. Cut three rectangles from the fabric. One will be 13" by 9", a second will be 10" by 7", and the last will be 6" by 3". When cutting, make sure you cut the rectangles according to how you would like the pattern to show on the completed bowtie.

Fold the two larger rectangles in half widthwise, with right sides together. Fold the smallest rectangle lengthwise, with right sides together. Making sure the print is going the direction you want it to go.
2. Pin around the edges of the two larger rectangles, leaving a 1" gap in the middle to use for turning your fabric right side out. Pin down the long side of the smallest rectangle leaving both ends open for turning the fabric right side facing out.
3. Turn all three rectangles with the pattern facing out. Invisible or machine stitch the open holes on all three rectangles closed.
4. Place the medium rectangle centered on the larger one and tack down to make sure the piece does not move.
5. Create a "Bow" effect by "fan" folding the two pieces together and stitching through the pinched area to hold to bow in place.
6. Place the smallest rectangle around the bow and determine how thick your pets collar is and sew the ends together. Trim down leaving about 1/8" seam.
