



## Envelope Pillow Cover

# Freckle + Lollie



## Supplies & Tools

- Pillow Insert 16x16 square
- 1 Yard Star Spangled D 65-N
- Coordinating thread
- Basic Sewing Materials (Scissors, Ruler, sewing needles, pins)
- Iron and Ironing Board

## Directions

1. Cut front side of pillow cover to 16"x16" square.

Cut two pieces for the back making sure the fabric is going in the same direction as the front. For each back piece cut 16"x13" rectangle. They should be the same width as the front (16")

2.

To get the proper measurements on length that your front width (16") divide it in half (8") and add 5" to get 13".

3.

Create a hem on both back pieces of the pillow by folding one 16" side over 1/2" and again another 1/2" and sew to create a finished edge.

4.

Place front piece and back pieces right sides together making sure the hem pieces for the back on in the middle and over lap each other. Pin all around pillow cover. Sew around the pillow case edges using a 1/2" seam allowance

5.

Optional Step: cut a diagonal at each corner of the pillow to ease the corners when turning. Stitch a zigzag stitch around the seam so the needle lands just off the fabric on the outer edge to keep from fraying.

6.

Turn pillow case right side out, add in your insert, and enjoy!

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
