## Reversible Bandana Bib

## Supplies & Tools

- 2 contrasting pieces of fabric from Autumn Glory Collection
- Coordinating thread
- Basic Sewing Materials (Scissors, Ruler, sewing needles, pins)
- · Iron and Ironing Board
- VelCro iron on or sew in (Optional Snaps)

## **Directions**

Print and cut out banana bib template at end of directions. There are two sized to

- **1.** chose from. Smaller bandana fits 11.5 neck circumference and larger fits 13" circumference.
- 2. Using the pattern, cut one pattern piece per fabric.
- With right sides together, stitch around the bandana use a 3/8" seam allowance. Leave a 3" opening at one of the two straight edges of the bib, this is marked on the pattern.
  - Trim off some of the seam allowance to make turning easier and not as bulky. We
- **4.** suggest leaving more seam allowance by the opening to allow the top stitch to close the opening completly.
- Turn bandana right side out. Fold the edged of the opening inside and press. Top stitch all around the bib 1/8" away from the edge making sure the opening is fully closed.
  - Iron on or sew in your Velcro, following directions on packaging, to the ends of the bib
- **6.** and your done!
  - \*Optional to use snaps in place of Velcro.
