



Novelty Neck Tie

SKILL LEVEL: BEGINNER

CRAFTING TIME: 1 HOUR

Supplies & Tools

- 1 1/2 Yards Or Luck pattern D47-Z
- 1/8 Yard Or Luck pattern D48-Z
- Printer to print pattern
- Basic Sewing Materials (Scissors, Ruler, sewing needles, pins)
- Iron and Ironing Board

Directions

1. Print out the pattern, cut, and tape together.

2. Pin the large pattern pieces to the main fabric on the bias and cut. Do the same for the smaller pattern pieces on the lining fabric. *There should be 2 large main fabric pieces and 2 small lining pieces.

3. With right sides together sew the two main fabric pieces together using a 1/2 inch seam allowance creating your long tie. Press the seam open.

4. Place the lining pieces on each end of the tie, right sides together. Stitch the sides and bottom using a 1/2 inch seam allowance leaving the top open. Clip the corners and turn lining right side out.

5. Press the edge of the tie over by 1/2 inch on the wrong side. Fold both sides in to the center overlapping by 1/4 inch and pin in place.

6. Using a slip stitch, stitch up the length of the tie making sure to only go through the fabric on the overlap and not the right side of the tie.

7. Press tie flat and it's ready to wear.

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
