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
Supplies & Tools


- Crown Template
- 1/2 yard of two coordinating Fabric Traditions fabrics
- 1/2 yard of Structure+ one side fusible interfacing from Fairfield World
- 1/2 yard of 1/2" coordinating color ribbon
- Basic sewing supplies (scissors, needle, thread)
- Sewing Machine

Directions

- 1. Using the pattern provided at the end of the directions. Tape together and cut out.
- Stack your two coordinating fabrics together. Place the crown template on top and pin into place. Cut around the template, making sure to cut through both layers. Repeat this step on your Structure+ interfacing using the interfacing pattern. Cut one piece of interfacing.
- Cut your ribbon in half. The length of each ribbon piece can be cut smaller based on preference.
- Center and place your Structure+ interfacing piece on the wrong side of one crown piece. Iron in place making sure the fusible side of the interfacing is face down. The best way to iron our interfacing is to use an ironing cloth or scrap piece of fabric.
- With one crown layer face up, place on ribbon on each short side of the crown. Place the other layer right side down on top, sandwiching the ribbon between. Make sure the ribbon is not sticking out. Pin in place and stitch around the short sides and the crown top using a a 1/2" seam allowance.
- Clip the corners and trim down the seam allowance to reduce bulk. Turn the crown right sides out. Use a poking tool (we used chopsticks) to help push out the pointed ends of the crown.
- **7.** Turn the open bottom edge under 1/2 inch, pin, and stitch around the entire crown using a 1/4" seam allowance. Place on your childs head and enjoy!
