



Upcycled Tea Towels

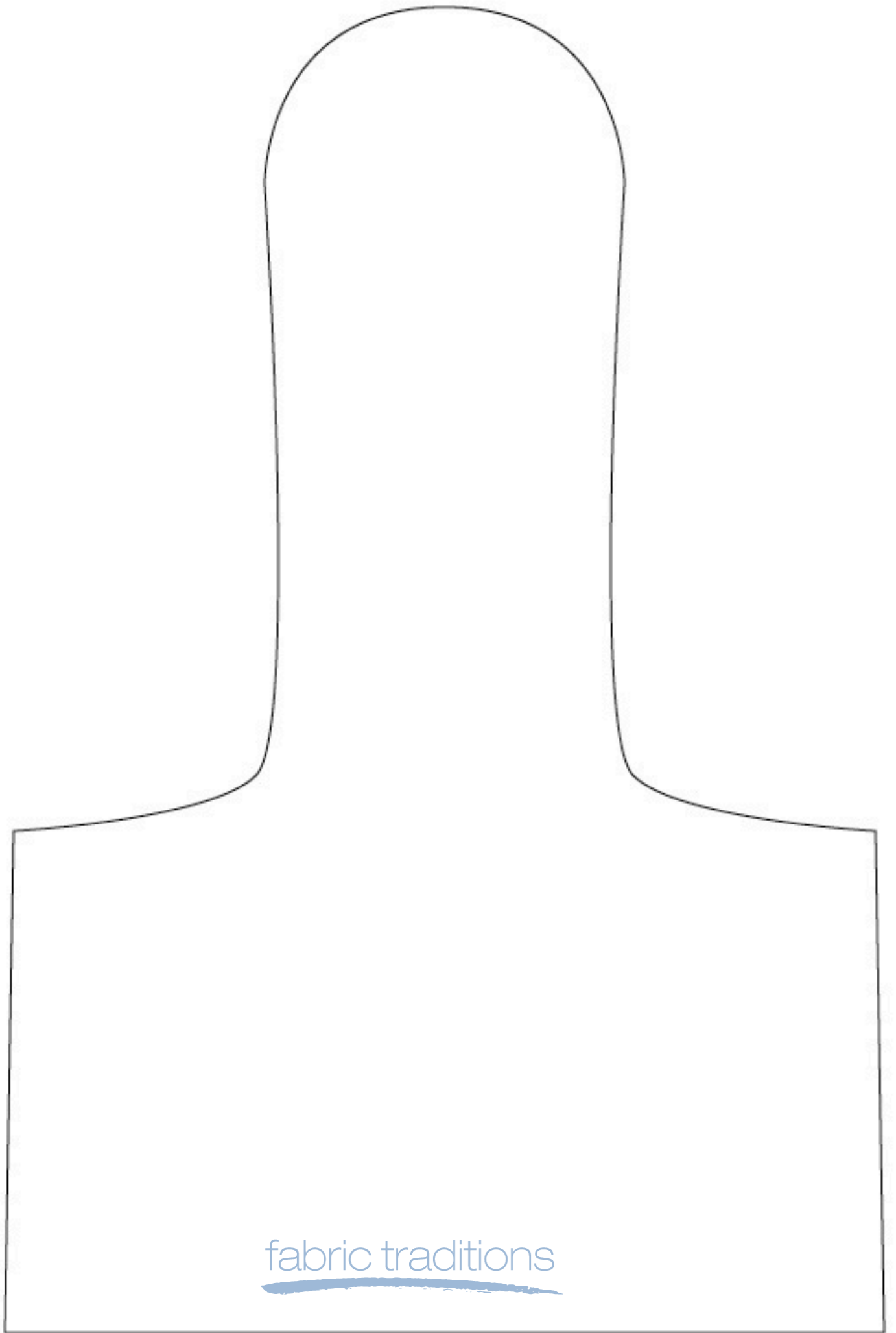
Supplies & Tools

- Hanging pattern
- Dish towels
- 1/4 yard fabric
- Button
- Basic sewing supplies (scissors, needle, thread)
- Sewing Machine

Directions

- 1.** Using the pattern provided at the end of the directions, cut out two pattern pieces.
- 2.** With right sides together, pin all around leaving the bottom open. Clip and notch the curves, turn right side out and press.
- 3.** Add a button hole to the long part of the hanger piece. Make sure your button hole fits the width of the button you are planning to use.
- 4.** Fold your towel in half, and then into thirds. Place inside the hanger. Fold under the raw edges up 1/2" in and press. Top stitch two parallel lines along the edge of the hanger to secure in place.
- 5.** Fold over the top long part until it meets a place you like on the hanger. Mark the location for the button.
- 6.** Sew the button in place of your marked location. Hang on your oven and enjoy!
