



Team Quilted Sunglass Case

SKILL LEVEL: Beginner

CRAFTING TIME: 1 to 2 Hours

Supplies & Tools

- Glasses case pattern
- 1/4yd of MLB fabric
- 1/4yd of coordinating lining fabric
- 1/4yd of batting from Fairfield World
- 1/2" double fold bias tape
- 1 set of snaps
- Basic sewing supplies (scissors, needle, thread)
- Sewing Machine

Directions

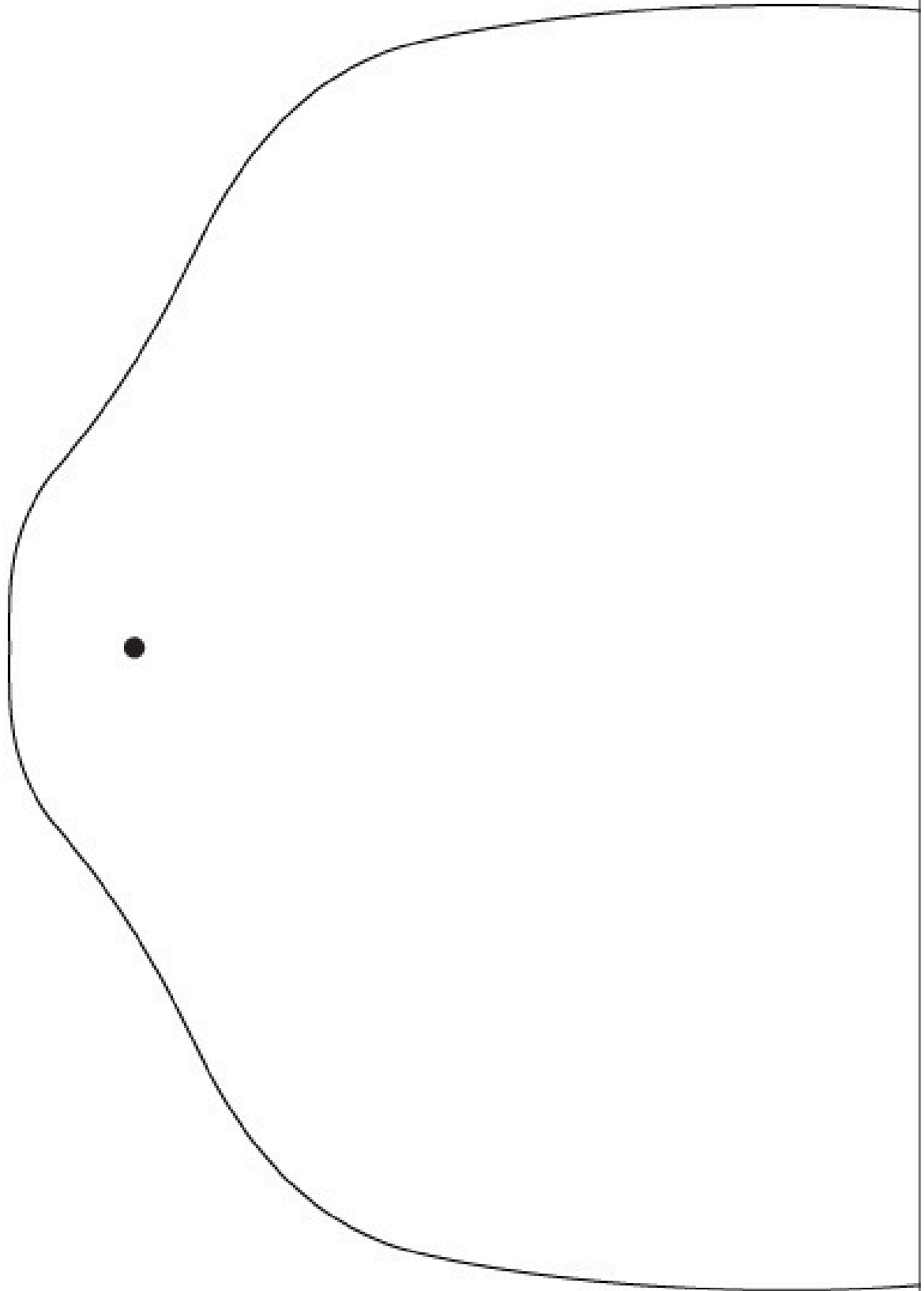
- 1.** Cut your main fabric, lining, and batting all to 10" wide by 12" tall. Print and cut out the sunglass case pattern found at the end of the directions.
- 2.** Sandwich the batting between your main fabric and lining fabric, making sure right sides are facing out, and quilt it together. We quilted ours using a diamond pattern.
- 3.** Pin pattern onto your quilted fabric and cut around. Make sure the pattern is facing the way you prefer. We wanted our logo to face upright on the back of the case.
- 4.** Following the directions on your bias tape package, pin and sew some of the tape to to the bottom edge. Trim the ends even with the fabric.

Fold the bottom edge up with wrong sides together at the dotted line and pin. Stitch both sides using a 1/4" seam allowance. *To help ease the bulking you can stitch with a tight zigzag stitch.
- 5.** Finish all the raw edges with the remaining bias tape. Make sure to flip in the raw edges of the bias tape before stitching down.
- 6.** Install your snaps following manufacturers instructions where the stud side is on the top flap and socket side is on the lining.
