Supplies & Tools

- 1 yd Fabric Traditions Fabric for main body
- 1 yd Fabric Traditions Fabric for Lining
- Printed Bag Pattern (Found Below)
- Matching thread
- Basic Sewing Materials (Scissors, Ruler, sewing needles, pins)

Directions

- 1.** Print out the pattern. Tape together and cut out. Use a ½ inch seam allowance for all seams.
- 2.** Cut out 2 outer pieces and 2 lining pieces from your FT Fabric.

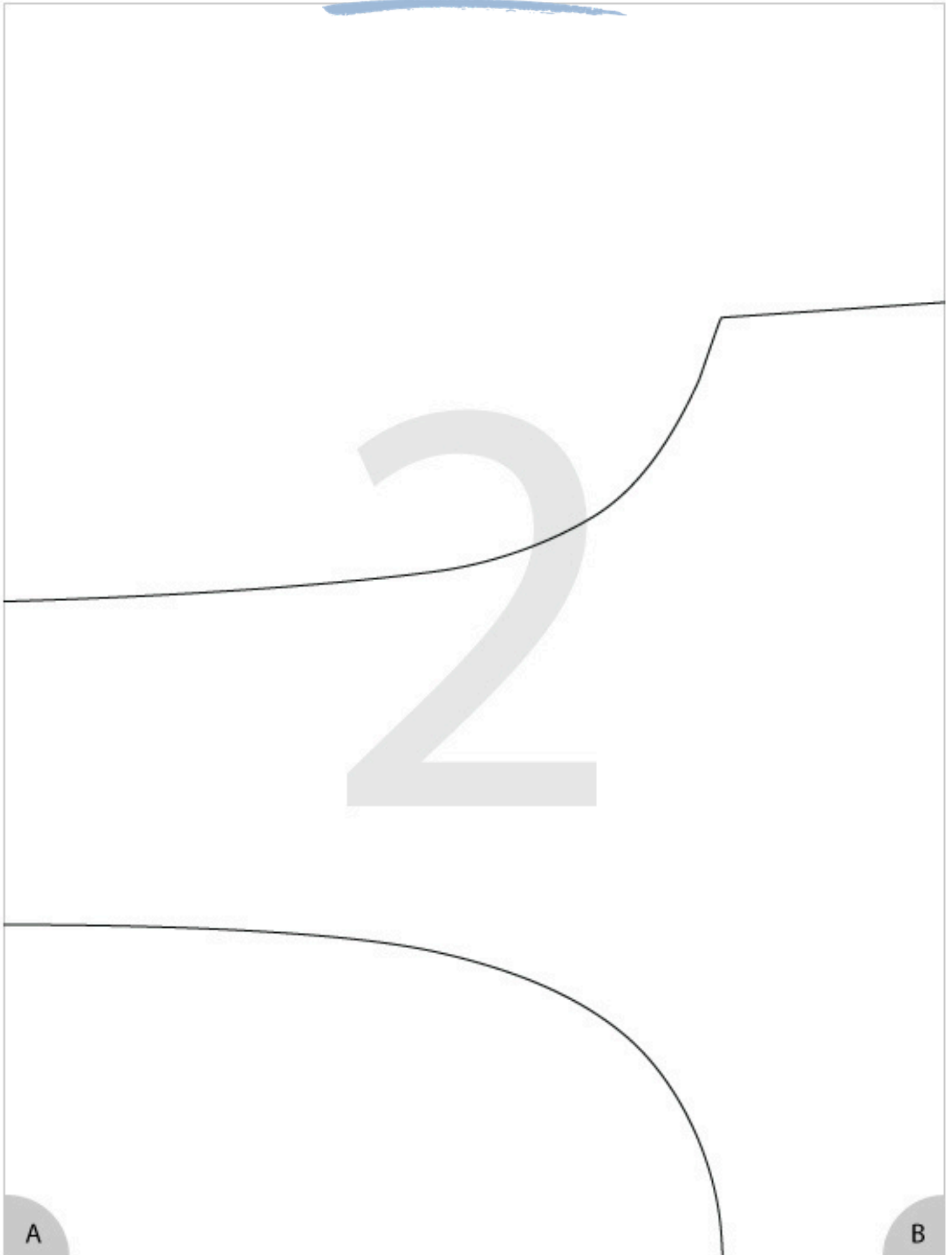
With right sides together, sew the two outer pieces together around the bottom of the bag. Repeat this step with the two lining pieces. Make sure to leave the straps alone at this point.
- 3.** Turn the lining bag right side out and place it inside the outer bag so right sides are together. Make sure to line them up at the side seams.

Pin and stitch the curved areas of the bag making sure to leave the straps unstitch.
- 4.** There will be four curved areas to stitch in between all the straps. Clip the curve areas for ease making sure to not clip into the stitching line.
- 5.** Carefully turn the bag right sides out by pulling the bag through one of the strap openings.

Press the edges of the straps under ½ inch. They should naturally fold under to match your seam allowance. Sew the ends (short side) of the outer straps right sides together. Repeat step for all outer strap pieces and then for the lining strap pieces.
- 6.** Match up the edges of the outer and lining straps together and pin. Top stitch around the inside and outside of the straps closing any openings in the bag straps and Enjoy!
