



Cinco De Mayo Tortilla Warmer

SKILL LEVEL: Beginner

CRAFTING TIME: 1 hour

Supplies & Tools

- ½ yard of FT for Michaels pattern 16246-Z for main (100% Cotton)
- ½ yard of FT for Michaels pattern 7823-R9 for lining (100% Cotton)
- 100% Cotton batting
- Matching thread
- Basic Sewing Materials (Scissors, Ruler, sewing needles, pins)

Directions

- 1.** Prepare your pattern. Place a plate or pot cover (12 diameter) on some craft paper. Trace around the object to create a circle.
- 2.** Using your pattern cut out two pieces from your main fabric, two pieces from your lining fabric, and two pieces from your cotton batting.
- 3.** Place one piece of your main fabric pieces on top of one piece of your batting, making sure the right side is facing up.
- 4.** Take one of your lining pieces and place it on top of your main fabric/batting piece, making sure right side is face down. Repeat with your other three pieces of fabric/batting.
- 5.** Using a 1/4" seam allowance, stitch around each circle making sure to leave a 2" opening for turning your pieces right sides out.
- 6.** Turn both circles right sides out and iron flat making sure the raw edge is folded inward. Top stitch around each entire circle using a 1/8" seam allowance.
- 7.** Take both circles and face them right sides together. Pin half way around the tortilla warmer. Start sewing starting at one pinned area and ending on the other pinnend area using a 1/8" seam allowance.
- 8.** Turn your tortilla warmer right side out and enjoy!

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
