



Passport Holder

SKILL LEVEL: Beginner

CRAFTING TIME: 1 hour

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Supplies & Tools

- ½ yard FT for Michaels pattern 14140-Z (licens plates) for outer fabric
- ½ yard FT for Michaels pattern 16070-E (confetti) for lining fabric
- Polyfil Batting by Fairfield world
- Sewing Machine and matching thread
- Basic Sewing Supplies (Scissors, Ruler, sewing needles, pins/wonder clips)

Directions

1. Cut one 12 ½ inch by 6 ½ inch rectangle from your outer fabric, lining fabric, and batting.
2. Layer your outer fabric face up on top of your batting fabric and then your lining fabric face down on top making sure all the edges line up. Pin in place.
3. Stitch around all 4 edges of the rectabel using a ¼ inch seam allowance making sure to leave a 2 inch gap for turning.
4. Clip all four corners and turn right side out. Press flat and top stitch only the two short edges of your rectangle.
5. With your lining fabric facing up, fold the short edges of the passport in towards the center 2 inches to create a little pocket to hold your pass port. Press flat and pin.
6. With a ⅛ inch seam allowance, stitch along the four edges of the passport holder, making sure the turning hole is sewn closed.
7. Place your passport inside and enjoy!

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
