



Scrunchie

SKILL LEVEL: Beginner

CRAFTING TIME: 1 hour

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Supplies & Tools

- ¼ yard FT for Michaels pattern 3744-T (Jungle Babies Giraff print)
- 9 inches of ¼ inch wide elastic
- Sewing Machine and matching thread
- Tube turner - Optional
- Basic Sewing Supplies (Scissors, Ruler, sewing needles, pins/wonder clips)

Directions

1. Cut a strip of fabric 18 inches by 4 inches.
2. With right sides together, fold your strip in half down the long side, making sure to match the edges together and leave a 2 inch gap.
3. Turn the tube halfway to the right sides, matching the short raw ends together and making sure the gap in the stitching stays on the outside of the tube.
4. Stitch around the short ends of the tube. Stitching by a needle and thread can be easier then a machine for this step.
5. Turn right side out through the gap in your stitching.
6. Thread your elastic through your scrunchie. Over lap each end of the elastic by one inch and stitch them together. If you would like a tighter elastic, over lap the elastic more.
7. Stitch the gap closed using an invisible stitch and your done!

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
