Quick and Simple Bandana Top

SKILL LEVEL: Beginner

CRAFTING TIME: 2 Hours

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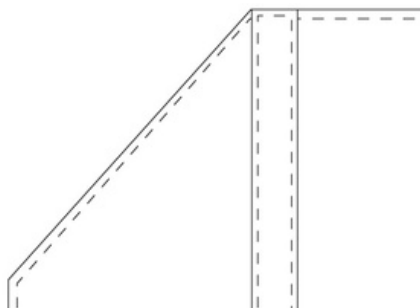
Supplies & Tools

- 1 yard MLB for FT fabric
- Bandana Top Pattern Piece (End of Directions)
- Removable fabric marker/chalk
- Sewing Machine and matching thread
- Basic Sewing Supplies (Scissors, Ruler, sewing needles, pins)

Directions

1. Print assemble and cut out the pattern at the end of the directions.
2. Fold your fabric in half wrong sides together so that the fabric pattern is in a vertical direction.
3. Using your Bandana top pattern, place on the fold. Make sure your pattern matches the direction of the print so that the top of the print matches the top of the pattern.

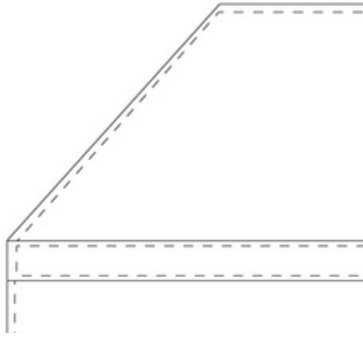
Create a single hem around the entire top at ¼ inch, press flat and stitch. On all diagonal sides fold over a second time, press, and stitch in place, leaving the top and sides with a single hem.
4. Cut out four 4inch by 18inch strap pieces. With one of your straps fold in half lengthwise with right sides together. Stitch using a 1/4" stitch around one short end and down the long end. Turn right side out, fold in the raw edge on the open side, press flat and top stitch around the entire strap making sure the opening end is stitched shut. Repeat this step for the other three strap pieces.
5. Line up one short end of one strap piece to the top left corner of your top, pin and stitch in place. Repeat this step for the right top corner.

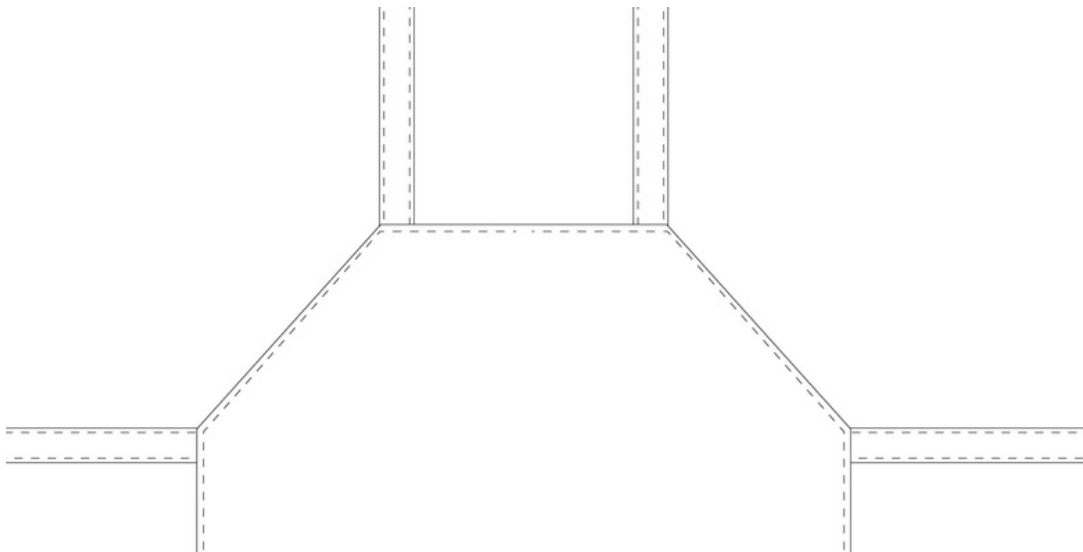
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Directions

7. Line up one short end of one strap to the left side corner of your top, pin, and stitch in place. Repeat this step for the right side.



8. Now that all the straps are stitched on, fold the top straps up and the side straps out, making sure to fold over the seams of the top. Top stitch the top and sides making sure to back stitch over the straps so they are extra secure.



9. Try on your top and wear to your favorite baseball game!
