Team Wreath Sash

SKILL LEVEL: Beginner

CRAFTING TIME: 1 Hour

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Supplies & Tools

- 2 yard MLB for FT fabric
- Sewing Machine and matching thread
- Basic Sewing Supplies (Scissors, Ruler, sewing needles, pins)

Directions

1. Cut out two strips of fabric at 4 ½ inch wide by 54 ½ inch long.
2. Place the two strips right sides together and pin around all 4 edges. On one of the long sides, mark off a 4 inch gap to use for turning.
3. Cut a 45 degree angle on each short side of the strips to make points for your sash.
4. Stitch around all four sides of your sash using a ¼ inch seam allowance, making sure to leave a 4 inch gap where marked.
5. Turn your sahs right sides out making sure to poke out the corners. Press the sash flat.
6. Using a slip stitch (invisable stitch), stitch your gap closed.
7. Optional: top stitch around the entire sash close to the edge making sure to close the gap.
8. Drape your sash over where you want it to sit on the wreath. Tie your sash on your wreath using a method of your liking, making sure the “knot” is hidden on the back of your wreath.
9. Hang your wreath on your door and enjoy!

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
